Don't forget the following:

- ARC Classes: You have been pre-enrolled into your ARC courses: BA 101: Introduction to Business and BA 199: Professional Development. These courses have already been added to your schedule. Please do not drop these classes. You will be able to add more courses to your schedule once you attend IntroDUCKtion this summer and meet with your adviser.
- Books for Biz Scholarship: As a BizARC resident, you are eligible to apply to receive a \$200 book scholarship available to 25 students for each term of your first year in the Business ARC. - **Biz ARC Orientation:** All BizARC residents will participate in a mandatory orientation after moving into their residence hall and during week of welcome. There you will meet Lundquist College of Business faculty and staff, the Associate Dean and Faculty Director for the ARC, members of your undergraduate advising team and Mohr career services, and JB housing complex support staff, all whom are ready to guide you through your first year. You will receive information about the specific date, time location in your welcome letter and closer to September.
- Flight School: All BizARC residents have been enrolled into our Flight School mentorship
 program where you'll be assigned a group with an upper-classmen in weekly meetings and
